

## CSIF (CH) Equity Switzerland Minimum Volatility Blue

### Class DB

#### Investment policy

The fund is managed with an indexed approach and is distinguished by its broad diversification, minimal tracking error, and cost-effective management. Strategy indices deliberately deviate from market capitalization in their weighting in order to capture factor premiums or reduce the investment risk.

MSCI Minimum Volatility is a strategy index that determines the portfolio with the least volatility from the stocks of the parent MSCI index. The index has historically shown lower realized volatility and lower beta relative to the MSCI parent index, with a bias toward stocks in smaller companies, less volatile stocks, and stocks with lower idiosyncratic risks.

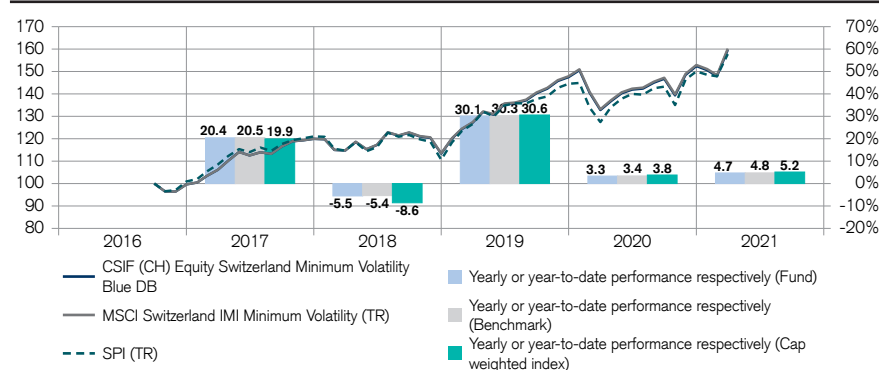

#### Exclusion of controversial weapons producers <sup>4)</sup>

Credit Suisse Index Funds will no longer invest in companies which are involved in the development or production of nuclear, biological, and chemical warfare agents, anti-personnel mines and cluster bombs.

Hence we position ourselves in line with the exclusion list from the Swiss Association for Responsible Investments (SVVK - ASIR). The tracking quality of our index funds remains broadly unchanged by these exclusions.

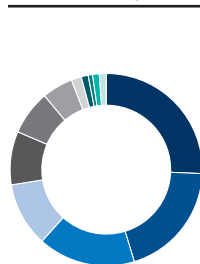
#### Net performance in CHF (rebased to 100) and yearly performance <sup>1)</sup>
